2. APPROVAL OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved by Matt Mycielski and seconded by Peter McLean

3. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE PREVIOUS MINUTES

3.1 Previous Commemoration

It was agreed by all that the 2009 commemoration had gone off very smoothly. Bryan mentioned the delay in the flypast. This is out of our hands. Martin asked why the flypast had not come over the monument. According to Peter, we will have 3 Hercules aircraft this year. The paperwork has gone in to Derrick, but no confirmation has been received as yet. Peter suggested that he, Andrzej and Col. Olmesdahl should meet to discuss the flypast. Peter and Andrzej to liaise.

Bryan also mentioned the seating at the reception. The VIP guests seated against the wall are not able to see the dancing. It was decided to do away with the tables and to seat the VIPs on the left and right of the pulpit.

Zbig spoke about the webcast. He said that he had sent emails out around the world and that the cast had been very well received, but there had been comments about the fact that it was mainly in English. Maybe a simultaneous Polish commentary would be the answer. Andrzej thanked the Dziembowskis for the fine job they had done and asked about the possibility of another cast this year. Zbig said he would speak to his sons and ask them about the possibility of a Polish commentary. Would subtitles in Polish be feasible?

3.2 Income and Expenses for 2009

Stefan Marek presented the Income Statement. Costs are generally up, and the bar made a loss of around R850.00. This could be due to free drinks for the VIPS and soldiers, as well as free cool drinks for the children. Stefan said it would be better not to eat into our capital and suggested rather that the price of the meal and drinks should be increased. It was decided to make the meal R70.00 per person and push up the price of the drinks by a few rand. Last year the committee had received a rather large donation from the Polish government, as there were dignitaries from Poland attending the service, but this will not be the case for 2010. Extra money was spent on food and flowers in 2009. We will buy

less cheese this year. Andrzej felt that the Embassy would make a donation, as they do so every year. Stefan stressed that we are not in dire straits, but that we need to be careful. Ron thanked the ladies in the kitchen and the barmen.

Maciek suggested that we should tighten up and give only one free drink to the kids who help. He also felt that the committee should pay for their meals. Krystyna emphasised that the ladies in the kitchen should not have to pay, as they spend the whole day working and don't get a chance to see anything of the service or reception.

The Income and Expenditure Statement was approved. Andrzej thanked Stefan for his hard work.

4. PROGRAM FOR THE 2010 SERVICE AND DISTRIBUTION OF FUNCTIONS

4.1 Katyn Memorial

There would be the usual program at the Katyn Memorial. VIPS to be invited. We need to find a guest of honour. With regard to logistics, Andrzej said he would write a letter General Gagiano via Derrick Page.

It was decided that Febe Potgieter Gqubule should be invited to the next meeting, if she would like to attend, and also to the service. Jean to forward minutes and invitation to the meeting.

4.2 In Memoriam

Bryan made a list of people who have died during the last year – Mrs Colman, Mrs Jean Martin (wife of Bernie Martin from 178 Squadron), Mr Billy Whitelaw (Barbara's brother). President of Poland and his party of 96 who died at Katyn in April. Andrzej added Capt. Frans Murray who died in his 90s.

4.3 National anthems and Scottish piper

Peter has this in hand.

4.4 Religious Service

Religious service to be conducted by Bryan and Robin, and Father Bogdan Wilkaniec. Jerzy's cousin may also be available.

Bryan asked about the mission statement of the Warsaw Flights committee. He said he felt it was rather vague. Andrzej read it out as written at the bottom of the letterhead. "To perpetuate the memory of the allied airmen who delivered supplies to The Polish Home Army to aid The Warsaw Uprising."

Bryan suggested that perhaps a rabbi should be part of the religious service. Bryan and Andrzej to speak about this at a later date. Andrzej stressed that the Jews were Poles as well, and so are remembered under the blanket of all Poles who died, and Jewish airmen are remembered with all the allied airmen.

4.5 Wreath Layers, Posthumous award for Herbie Brown

Bryan made some suggestions with regard to wreath layers. Richard Klette for 31 Squadron, Alf Heale for 34 Squadron, Johan van der Merwe (who was ground crew) for 2 Wing. Andrzej felt it would be better to stick with the Durrants with regard to the latter. Shirley will not be here for the service, so cannot lay the 178 wreath. Jane Neuhofer could lay the wreath for 148 Squadron. She is the daughter of Bernie Martin who flew for 148 Squadron.

Bryan also spoke of honouring Herbie Brown who was shot on the ground at Warsaw airport in 1944 and was taken by the Germans and never seen again. He was part of Bryan's crew. Bryan suggested that a tombstone should be erected for him at the

Krakow's Rakowicki Cemetery, and also a posthumous award considered. He is apparently buried as a Canadian in Lodz. It would be necessary to speak to the Commonwealth War Graves Commission – The Committee should approach them, as this would have more clout. Peter said he would find the contact. It was agreed that giving a posthumous award could be tricky, as there may be others eligible as well. Some thought would need to be given to this matter.

4.6 Keynote speaker

The keynote speaker came up for discussion. Andrzej said that he hoped that the Polish Ambassador would do the welcome address. Bryan has suggested Lt Gen Earp as the speaker and Andrzej has approached him, but he is not keen and will think about it. Jean suggested Gen Page or Gen Gagiano. There is a new British attaché – Clive Mitchell, and Thornton Schultz is apparently a very good speaker. There is also a new American military attaché, above Schultz, who will be arriving soon. Stefan Mathews suggested Gen Knobel. The SA Minister of Defence, Lindewe Sisulu was also mentioned by Ron Haywood. We need to give some serious thought to this matter.

Ron suggested asking President Zuma. Ron to get his address and Ron and Andrzej to liaise in this regard.

The new Australian Ambassador was suggested or the Australian High Commissioner. If not invited as speakers, they should be invited to lay a wreath.

4.7 Invitations

Invitations to be sent out by Jerzy. They will go out on 1 August. All names to go to Jerzy by 15 June. Replies to go to Jean and Andrzej. Jean will forward them to Jerzy and Zbig.

Andrzej to get a list of VIPS. Aubrey van der Bijl used to deal with combatants, but has been ill. Andrzej to speak to Carole van Rensburg. Ron mentioned the new Gauteng Veterans' Chairman – Mike Hardisty. Perhaps he will be able to help.

Bryan mentioned his additions to the guest list.

MINUTES OF MEETING NO 02/2010

1. ATTENDANCE

1.1 Present

Andrzej welcomed everyone and commented on the good turnout.

2. APPROVAL OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved. Zbigniew said that Jean should sign the minutes, as she takes them.

3. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE PREVIOUS MINUTES

3.1 Previous Commemoration

Line 8 - Tomek Kuhn expressed concern about doing away with the tables for the VIPS. It was decided that the VIPS should be seated closer to the dancing, but the tables should remain. There is less happening at the reception this year, as the keynote address will be given at the religious service. The Polish Consul will give an address and Gen Kriegler will be awarded the Pro Patria medal at the reception, so there will be more time for Polish dancing.

3.2 Income and Expenses for 2009

Line 5 - Andrzej said he and Jurek Sadowski had decided to keep the price of the reception at R50.00 per head, because of the bad economic climate. Children up to 12 years of age to pay R10. Andrzej said the committee should pay as well. Only VIPS to be free of charge.

4.1 Katyn Memorial

Line 1 - Andrzej said that we can expect more diplomats among the VIPS at the service this year. The Belgian Ambassador, H.E. J.F. Mutton will attend, and for the first time, the Italian Defence Attaché will be there. An invitation has also been extended to the Italian Ambassador, Elio Menzione. Andrzej mentioned that one of the ex-South African Ambassadors to Poland, Victor Zazeraj will be present. He would have attended the committee meeting as well, but had a prior engagement.

Line 2 - Andrzej confirmed that Col. T.C. Schultz has agreed to do the keynote address, and that he would receive his C.V. shortly.

Andrzej, Jean and Martin have spoken to Brig Gen Page. He confirmed that all arrangements including the flypast are in place.

4.5 Wreath Layers, Posthumous award for Herbie Brown

Line 7 – Andrzej said he had written to Captain Ross of the Commonwealth Graves Commission – his letter has been received and they will reply in due course – they are sympathetic to the cause.

4.8 Publicity

Jean reported that there has been a lot of coverage in the Caxton Press - 4-Ways Chronicle, Rosebank and Killarney Gazette, North Eastern Tribune, and yesterday (27/8) The Sandton Chronicle, have all carried info about the service. Material has also been forwarded to 702.

6. GENERAL

Line 1 - Stefan Mathews confirmed that the annual remembrance lunch for the Warsaw Uprising of 1944 had been cancelled. There were too few people attending. Andrzej said it would be better if it were not so close to the Warsaw Flights service. Maybe an event should be held around April – the date of the Katyn Massacre. The Siberian Deportees could also be included.

4. PROGRAMME OF THE 66TH COMMEMORATION

- a draft version of this is attached -

4.1 Jean will make labels for the VIP seating. Only VIPS and wreath layers will have allocated seats. List of guests to be forwarded to her asap.

4.2 Andrzej said that Bryan is our only Warsaw Flights survivor and so is unique. Bryan expressed his appreciation.

4.3 Bryan asked if Derrick Watts had been invited. Martin undertook to look into this. (Derrick Watts has since been invited by email. He has replied and cannot attend.)

4.4 Ron said that he would approach the Afrikaans radio station to speak about the service.

4.5 There was some discussion about the **In Memoriam**. Bryan asked if Olive's brother, Charles Hibbard, could be added. Andrzej will also add Brian Slade (a fellow volley ball player) to the list and he will speak about the great tragedy at Smolensk in April.

4.6 The national anthems will be played on the bagpipes and the piper has been booked. Bryan suggested that the anthems be sung, but Andrzej said that Warsaw Flights is the only service where the anthems are piped and he would like to keep it that way.

4.7 The religious service was discussed. Bryan said Robin would come to the committee meeting a little later, as he has a previous engagement. He asked Andrzej what direction Robin should follow – Andrzej suggested he speak on the great tragedy at Smolensk, a second Katyn in a manner of speaking. He asked Bryan to have something to say in case Col Schultz' speech was shorter than the allocated 10 mins. Bryan to do the final blessing.

5. WREATHS – draft list attached -

Martin undertook to phone Richard Durrant for 2 Wing and 205 Group, Bryan to speak to Richard Klette for 31 Squadron, Alf Heale for 34 Squadron and Jane Neuhoffer for 148 Squadron. Peter said he would lay the wreath for 178 Squadron. Mira Sobczyk will lay

the 1586 Polish Special Duties Flight wreath and Stan Czuba will pay for it. Glenn and Barbara will lay the Alpine 44 wreath and Martin will lay the Warsaw 44 Club wreath. The UK Air Adviser, Wing Commander C. Mitchell has not responded to the invite. Peter said he would investigate. (WC Mitchell has since confirmed his attendance).

6. RECEPTION AT THE MILITARY MUSEUM – See attached draft -

Andrzej said that more time would be allocated to dancing.

Ron suggested that Andrzej should give a speech, highlighting Polish history – what happened at Smolensk, the current situation in Poland etc.

Stefan asked if Lt Gen Knobel could address the audience. Andrzej said he could possibly speak next year.

Andrzej said he would meet with Rev. Bogdan Wilkaniec. Perhaps some of the Polish nuns who take care of children in Siloe near Polokwane could also attend the service.

Jacek Dziembowski arrived at this point to speak about the webcast.

7. WEBCAST

Jacek said the webcast would take the same format as last year. Andrzej confirmed that there would be a backup generator in case the power fails.

Jacek asked if the webcast had been advertised overseas.

Jean undertook to try for something in the Daily Telegraph and also to contact Norman Davies (Norman Davies has been contacted and has replied and will try to watch the service live if time permits).

There was some discussion about a Polish commentary. This would be very difficult to achieve, as a very fast translator would be needed. Maybe names and titles of the wreath layers could be texted along the bottom of the video and as much Polish as possible used. This would be quite a technical challenge – spelling mistakes cannot be corrected. Jacek said he would need the most up to date list to avoid mistakes. Andrzej undertook to get this to him.

It was agreed that the congregation should be shown in the video as well.

Andrzej said he had hoped to get an interview with the Polish Press, in SA for the World Cup, but had not been able to. Information about the webcast should be sent to the Polish Press and advertised on the internet. The Uprising Museum in Warsaw should be contacted, and Ron suggested that the Hamilton Scout Group be informed so that they can watch.

Andrzej thanked Antfarm for the tremendous effort they have put in. Jacek said they would be available to help again next year. He said he would be away on 4th September, but his brother would be there.

Andrzej thanked Zbigniew for all the effort and praised his sons.

Bryan expressed great enthusiasm for the webcast and suggested that we try to get info through to the USA. Maybe Col Schultz could help in this regard. Bryan also stressed the need to market the webcast.

8. GENERAL

8.1 Tomek mentioned a group of cyclists who will be in South Africa at the time of the service. They are contactable through Piotr Plebankiewicz. Andrzej said they would be very welcome to attend. Andrzej to make contact.

8.2 Ron undertook to speak to the Jeppe Scout master. His name is Robert Faltermeier (RFaltermeier@jeppeboys.co.za).

8.3 Ron said that General Msimang is coming to the service and stressed the importance of his attendance for future services.

8.4 Jean mentioned the problems with the bank account this year. Some guests have struggled to make payment. Stefan Marek said he would look into making a change for next year.

8.5 Andrzej reported that James and Ethel Gray Park is clean and that the vagrant who always sleeps there, always disappears for the duration of the service.

8.6 The wreaths, if ordered through Krystyna's friend, will cost R150 each – a very good price.

8.7 Martin said Derrick had said that the flypast would come over the Monument this year.

3. MATTERS ARISING

3.1 Comments on Previous Commemoration

It was agreed that the service was very successful with a good attendance.

3.1.1 Bank Account ✓

Jean mentioned the recurring problems with the bank account. People wanting to pay for the lunch struggled to put through electronic transfers owing to branch code problems, resulting in the committee sometimes losing out on donations. Stefan Marek suggested we deal with the problems on an individual basis, or open a transmission account. The set up with tables and chairs for VIPs worked well. Only one general, who arrived late, was without a seat. Youth must be encouraged to give up seats to VIPs and the elderly. **It was suggested that some extra chairs be kept aside outside as backup.**

3.1.3 Map for Venue (lost in fire)

Andrzej said that some people had struggled to find the reception venue and so he has scanned the map used for VIP invitations. **Martin undertook to get the GPS co-ordinates for both venues.**

3.1.4 Webcast

3.2 Income and Expenses for 2010

Income for the period ended 30 April 2011 amounted to R20 891,79

Expenses for the same period were at R24 094,10

There was therefore a net loss of R3 202,31.

The current bank balance of R32 344,96 is healthy.

Stefan praised Krystyna for reducing the catering costs by 23%. Bar costs were also down.

Costs for flowers were high, as some of the wreaths have not been paid for yet. Jean suggested that accounts be emailed to wreath layers before the event. **Jean to organise this and Andrzej to forward the email addresses of Polish Associations' wreath layers to her.**

Dziem suggested that we try to get a better interest rate on our investment. **Andrzej and Stefan to look into this**, but Stefan said that although we could obtain a better rate, we could also incur additional costs.

The financial statement was accepted. Proposed by Peter McLean and seconded by Martin Urry.

4&5 DISTRIBUTION OF FUNCTIONS FOR 2011 AND PROGRAM

Andrzej confirmed that the next service will be held on Saturday 3 September 2011 and that the reception venue has been booked.

The Distribution of Functions list will be forwarded to the committee in due course with the minutes.

Various points were raised with regard to Dist of Functions and Program :

4&5.1 Invitations

Jurek to see to the invitation list – important to get all new names to him as soon as possible. Andrzej handed over returned to sender invites and Jurek handed over 2010 guest list.

Andrzej would like Kurt Scheurer to be invited to the service. He is a new friend and an important member of the Swiss community. As a boy he saw Polish troops in Switzerland, and wants to interact with the Polish community.

Bryan asked that Dr and Mrs M Musk, Dr and Mrs Boyes-Varley, Sister Barbara Lace and Mr Derek Watts be removed from the list.

Jurek mentioned that the Katyn Memorial map, used as an attachment to the invitations, had been drawn by Jack van Eyssen and is therefore part of the history of the commemorations. **It was suggested that he mention this on the map. Acceptance and apologies to go to Andrzej, Jean and Dziem.**

It was noted that Febe Potgieter-Qubule is still keen to attend, but is currently busy studying for her PhD.

Jurek will send out the invitation a month before the service. He will attach the maps with GPS co-ordinates.






Request for exhumation and re-burial of the remains of W/O Herbert Brown

On behalf of our Committee and survivors of the Warsaw Flights, I would like to ask your office to investigate the possibility of exhumation and re-burial in Poland of the remains of Warrant Officer 2nd Class Herbert Brown (SAAF No - 328832V). As air gunner of the crew of the Liberator of Lt. Bob Klette, he took part in the heroic flights over Warsaw by the South African Air Force to drop supplies to the Polish Home Army in Warsaw on the night of 13/14 August 1944. They crash landed in Warsaw. Herbert Brown was badly injured by enemy fire and separated from the rest of the imprisoned crew to be treated in hospital. He subsequently died from his wounds.

To the best of our knowledge (see attached press article), his remains have been buried in the small civilian churchyard at the city of Lodz in central Poland, and he has been mistakenly described as "Canadian Pilot H. J. Brown". Due to the fact that he had been separated from the rest of his crew (who subsequently survived and returned to South Africa), no information was available at the time to unite his remains with the rest of the Allied Airmen and bury them at the Rakowicki Cemetery in Krakow. His best friend Eric Winchester, after 54 years of searching, in 1998 found his remains at Lodz. Regretfully at the time he did not apply for them to be re-united with the rest of the SAAF airmen, their rightful place of eternal rest. We would like to correct this unfortunate error now, and to close this unusual chapter of his route. Thank you for your interest and help.







REQUEST FOR EXHUMATION : WARRANT OFFICER HERBERT BROWN

Your letter dated 06 July 2010 requesting the exhumation of Warrant Officer Brown refers.

As the North Europe Area Office of the Commonwealth War Graves Commission is responsible for the Commonwealth graves in Poland your request was forwarded to them for further investigation and action.

The Commonwealth War Graves Commission's Honorary Supervisor in Poland pursued the matter and reported as follows:

According to the Polish Red Cross records, made soon after World War 2, Warrant Officer Herbert Brown was buried in a Lodz Doly cemetery, grave 2 / 3-6.

There are 7 different cemeteries in Lodz Doly which includes Roman – Catholic, Municipal, Military, Orthodox, Baptist, Pentecostal and Marianvite.

Searches in the Military or the Municipal cemeteries did not reveal the grave of WO Brown.

Information received from the Roman – Catholic cemetery indicated that the WO Brown in all probability was buried in the cemetery. Unfortunately the grave does not exist anymore.

INVESTOR IN PEOPLE

The cemetery authority confirmed that a ceremony was held around 1999 to commemorate WO Brown. This ceremony was attended by representatives, family members and diplomats. (*This is obviously the ceremony, which took place in 1998, and is referred to in your letter and the attached newspaper cutting.*)

A plaque on the wall of the cemetery in memory of WO Brown remains.

The above indicates that Warrant Officer Herbert Brown was most probably buried in the Roman – Catholic cemetery in Lodz Doly at the time of his death and that the grave has since been lost with only the commemorative plaque remaining. A picture of the commemorative plaque is attached.

Warrant Officer Brown is commemorated on the Malta Memorial and as double commemoration is not Commission policy the South African Agency must regrettable consider the matter closed.

Please note that, due to the Gautrain, the Trichardt Road offramp from the highway to Pretoria no longer exists.

To get to Bays Hill you need to take the new offramp – Wierda Road/Sunderland Ridge, this is after the Jean Road offramp and before the previous Trichardt Road offramp. The road loops back to a T-junction and stop street. Turn Right to Sunderland Ridge and proceed 2.5 km to the Old Johannesburg Road. Turn Right onto the Old Johannesburg Road and proceed 3.5 km past the Zwartkop Airfield and the SAAF museum on your right. The next traffic lights are at the Paul Kruger Street/Snake Valley Road intersection, turn Right into Snake Valley Road. After 800 meters you will see the Bayhill memorial on your Right.

The Officer in the Order of King Leopold II, is bestowed with honour upon Charles C.G. Huyghé in recognition for his exceptional duty to Belgium, to Belgium people and to his fellow men all over the world.

During World War II - after the fall of Belgium - Charles displayed his courage and distinguished devotion to his country during the occupation. Whilst working with the 'underground', both in Belgium and France, he assisted in the concealment, and the escape, of both Jewish, and other refugees, from occupied Europe. Despite being captured by the Gestapo he managed to escape and make his way to Great Britain. There he joined the Royal Air Force – with Bomber Command - and served throughout the rest of the war with distinction

After the war, late in 1945, he was transferred to the Congo, in the province of Katanga. Some years later, appointed to the rank of Colonel, he was responsible and instrumental, during the Congo Rebellion, in the Province of Katanga, securing the safety and protection of Belgium people, and other nationals. At times under quite severe and harrowing conditions.

During 1963, Charles came to South Africa as the Hon. Belgium Delegate. Here, he has continued to work, with total commitment for the benefit of the Belgium Community. Assisting those nationals residing within South Africa.

Charles presently holds: The Knighthood in the Order of the Crown – together with the Order of Leopold I, the Coix de Guerre, with two Bars and several other distinctions.

Our member Charles (Carlo) Huyghe, nephew of the famous General Huyghe, who for his brilliant military conduct of the 1917 offensive in German East Africa, was given the noble title of "Sir" by King Albert 1st, and was authorized to use the name of Huyghe De Mahenge. Has been honoured once again by the Belgian Government.

Already the recipient of the Cross of the Knight of the Order of Leopold 1st and the Order of the Crown and numerous Military distinctions that he received for his service in the Belgian Army Reserves in 1940, and in the armed resistance followed by his stint in the RAF.

Carlo Huyghe has received the Order of the Officer of Leopold 11 and has the title of the Belgian Delegate for Belgians Abroad in South Africa. We should also remember that our member is the recipient of several high Katangese decorations, for his active participation in the fight against the Mutiny of the Colonial Army in Elizabethville in July 1960 and his function as Colonel in the Katangese Army and Chief of the Cabinet of the Minister of Defence.

At 87 "always good feet and good eyes" ,a member of numerous patriotic associations. Carlo Huyghe continues to devote himself to the interests of Belgians living in South Africa.

The decoration bestowed on him at the Belgian Embassy during a reception on the 15th of May 2009.

We wish him many more years in the service of his country and we congratulate him for his well merited decoration.


He was, on 15 May 2009, at a ceremony at the Belgian Embassy, presided over by the Ambassador Mr J. Mutton, who on behalf of King Albert the 2nd, invested as an Officer of the Prestigious Order of King Leopold the 2nd (equivalent of an OBE)

The award was granted to Charles for his exceptional duty to the Belgian Community in South Africa over many years.

Other notable achievements that were mentioned by the Ambassador were that Charles served as a pupil Officer in the Belgian army in WW2, was seriously wounded and taken P.O.W. in 1940. He escaped in 1941 and joined the armed resistance where he was instrumental in rescuing and hiding many Jewish children from occupied Belgium. With the Gestapo about to arrest him, he escaped again, this time to Great Britain where he joined the RAFVR.

Charles is also the recipient of the Croix de Guerre and Bar and the Croix of Armed Resistance, Knight of the Order of King Leopold the 1st and of The Order of the Crown.

In South Africa, Charles is the Delegate to the Union of French Speaking Belgians Abroad.

Si l'UFBE n'est pas encore jubilaire il n'empêche que de nombreux membres lui vouent un indéfectible attachement depuis l'année de leur inscription. Attachement couplé chez certains avec des fonctions bénévoles de délégué de l'UFBE pour la ville, la région où le pays où ils résident. Nous ne dirons jamais assez le rôle primordial de cette poignée de délégués qui assurent le rayonnement et l'action de l'UFBE à l'étranger tout en créant et maintenant des liens entre les compatriotes eux-mêmes et ceux-ci avec la Belgique. Natif d'Ixelles, c'est là que durant toute la guerre il dû vivre dans la clandestinité que lui imposait son statut de réfractaire. Bruxelles libéré ? En 44 le voilà volontaire de guerre à la RAF et sous-officier jusqu'à sa démobilisation en 1946.

Pas de temps mort : en mars 46 il débarque au Congo dans la territoriale

jusqu'en 52. L'administration lui pèse-t-elle un peu ? Il s'installe comme colon à Kasenga jusqu'en 1960. Juillet 60, il paie tant de sa personne dans la protection des biens et des personnes que le voilà intégré à de hautes fonctions dans la sécession Katangaise. L'ONU s'empressera de lui reprocher cet engagement en l'obligeant à gagner d'autres horizons : l'Afrique du Sud où, jusqu'en 86 -année de sa retraite- il fera preuve d'un beau dynamisme entrepreneurial.

Entre-temps, parmi une foule d'activités bénévoles, nous le trouvons délé-

gué officiel de l'UFBE depuis 1975. C'est là qu'il va faire preuve d'un altruisme sans faille, d'un dévouement social jamais pris en défaut. Non seulement il prend en charge les problèmes des membres de l'UFBE mais, aussi, il investigue auprès des autres compatriotes plus démunis pour leur offrir son aide.

Elzbieta Ruzyczka de Rosenwerth

Elzbieta was born in Warsaw, and prior to World War 2 lived in Warsaw and on the family farm in Western Poland. She matriculated in Warsaw and attended the “secret university” courses. Her father, Witold Kepinski, was a well-known eye surgeon who was one of the victims at Katyn.

In 1940 she joined the AK and was trained as a field nurse, being attached to the 1st regiment of Chevaux Legers, in which both of her brothers served.

In January 1944 she married Henryk Ruzyczka de Rosenwerth.

She joined the Uprising at Port Chrniakowski and when her company was ordered to withdraw to Mokotow she was left to help deliver the wounded to hospitals. Later, separated from her regiment in the centre of Warsaw, she helped wherever needed, attending to the wounded, guiding people to other parts of the city, firefighting and acting as a messenger.

After the surrender of Warsaw she was miraculously released from the Pruszkow camp and gave birth to her daughter, Dorota, four weeks later in Krakow.

Elzbieta left Poland with her husband and daughter in 1946 and lived in Paris and London, where she studied fashion design. The family arrived in South Africa in 1952. Elzbieta designed for the local fashion industry and open her own salon in 1968. She quickly became known as *the couturier of South Africa* and won many fashion awards – the one she treasures most is for her contribution to South African fashion.

For many years the bi-annual Rosenwerth fashion shows helped to raise many thousands of Rands for worthy causes. In 1982 a significant sum was raised for Solidarnosc – but it had the unfortunate consequence that, for a number of years, she was refused a visa to Poland.

Elzbieta insists that she could not have achieved what she did without the unbelievable support of her husband and her three daughters.


Today, her daughter Gabi is the designer of the firm but Elzbieta still takes a keen interest in the business and hates the thought of retiring.

DEPRAWACJA

Raz ktos zadal pytanie : co to jest deprawacja ?

Brytyjski slownik (Oxford Dictionary) haslo "deprave" wyjaśnia: "make morally bad, corrupt".

Slownik ten niestety nie wnosil ani slowa o tajnej antyludzkiej wojnie psychologicznej prowadzonej przez sily swiatowego lewactwa w celu utrzymania globalnej kontroli.

Deprawacja w tym znaczeniu, to redukcja psycho-etyki czlowieka do poziomu prymitywizmu instynktow zwierzeczyh.

Stwierdzono bowiem, ze zanizony poziom "morale" czlowieka ułatwia rządzenie, tak jak niskie "morale" wroga ułatwia atak. Polega to na obezwładnieniu systemu psycho-motywacyjnego oraz na zanizeniu odpornosci jednostki na sugestie.

Czlowiek poddany takiemu procesowi jest umysłowo nie pełnosprawny oraz posiada ograniczona zdolnosc myslenia (ang: brainwash !).

Na potwierdzenie powyzszego przytaczam opinie pana Rymkiewicza - poety, dramaturga i krytki literackiego wyrazona w jednym z jego wywiadow :

" pytanie : - Jak to sie dzieje, ze duza czasc naszych elit mowi diametralnie inaczej niz pan?

- Dlatego, bo to sa wyksztalciuchy. Trzeba powiedziec, ze Ludwik Dorn znalazl dobre slowo dokladnie oddajace tym ludziom to, co im sie nalezy. Sa to wyksztalciuchy, poniewaz PRL, potrzebujacy fachowcow, nie zle ich wyksztalcil w sensie zawodowym. Ale to slowo, ze wzgledu na swój ksztalt fonetyczny i koncowke, jest tez pelne pogardy... Mowi, ze wyksztalciuchy to sa ci, co wyksztalcili sie zawodowo, ale nie moralnie.. - sa egoistyczni, cyniczni, mysla tylko o wlasnym interesie i wlasnej karierze.

Istnienie wyksztalciuchow bylo wladcom PRL na reke, bowiem ludzi cynycznych łatwo jest cynicznie wykorzystywac.

Trzeba wyraznie odroznic wyksztalciucha od inteligenta.

Wyksztalciuchy nie sa polskimi intelligentami, nie maja prawa aspirowac do takiego miejsca w naszych dziebach. Przynaleznosc do polskiej inteligencji byla bowiem i pozostaje czynem moralnym.

Kto niegdys wchodzil do tej warstwy, przyjmował na siebie fundamentalna powinnosc - sluzenia wspolnoscie, czyli sluzenia Polsce. A wyksztalciuchy sluzyl i sluzala tylko samym sobie - zyja tylko dla wlasnej przyjemnosci...." i dalej :

"Tych PRLowskich zawodowcow trzeba traktowac tak, jak na to zasluguja, czyli pilnowac, zeby za bardzo nie szkodzili Polsce. Moga przemawiac, cos mowic, ale trzeba im wtedy przypominac, ze zostali wyprodukowani przez PRL, sa amoralnym dzielem totalitaryzmu i wobec tego ich poglady moga byc brane pod uwage tylko w bardzo ograniczonym stopniu....."

Tyle cytat, który jasno wyszczególnia ludzi poddanych naciskom psychologicznym. Nie ma tez zadnych iluzji co do spolecznej szkodliwosci takich naciskow. Sluzyl, rzecz jasna, tylko wladzy !

Warto wspomniec o tragedji lat 40-tych, gdy oficerowie polscy zmasowani w obozach jenieckich na terenie ZSSR byli poddani selekcji, w wyniku ktorej najbardziej wartosciowy element podlegal likwidacji (Katyn!).

Pozostali bowiem, którzy wykazywali sie brakiem patriotyzmu lub innych pro-polskich sentymentow, mieli prawo zyc, by poznaj po dodatkowej stalinowskiej indoktrynacji zajmowac miejsca w PRLowskim rządzie, milicji, UB itd itp. Byla to typowa selekcja NEGATYWNA, ktorej skutki widoczne sa po dzien dzisiejszy.

Podobnie zdeprawowany element dochodził do głosu w całym Bloku Wschodnim. W kaznym z tych krajow, które zostały poddane działaniu tej lewacko- komunistycznej deprawacji wyloniła się warstwa deprawanców, ludzi o zwyrodnialych poglądach wyraźnie szkodzących społeczeństwu.

Jak do tego doszło ?

Blok Wschodni stał się, po sowieckiej Rosji, terenem wielkiego eksperymentu psychologicznego, a ludzi można było podzielić na:

- 1) tych, którzy całkowicie akceptowali sowiecki zamordyzm ;
- 2) i tych, którzy go nigdy nie akceptowali....!

Sowiecki system oparty na brutalnej sile wymazywał opozycje siły. Tylko w czasie pokoju (wg. Souzenicyna !) wymordowano około 50 milionów obywateli ZSSR. Głównym elementem rządzenia był strach. Z oponentów tylko nieliczni zdolali ujść z życiem, a scisiej, uszli z życiem głównie ci, którzy dobrze się maskowali. To naturalna potrzeba przeżycia dyktowała takie reakcje i trzeba wyraźnie nazwać główny element obronny ludzi : **klamstwo..!** Kto lepiej klamał i udawał, ten żył ! Kto nie potrafił klamać, ten ginał !... Dzieki takiej naturalnej reakcji, ludzie stali się dla siebie obcy, a powszechna podejrzliwość zajęła miejsce zaufania i współpracy. Tak zachowywali się ludzie tej 2-giej grupy, których była większość.

Do 1-szej grupy należeli przede wszystkiem ci, którzy system wymyslali i wprowadzali. Byli to na ogół społeczni prowokatorzy oraz ich ludzcy pracujący za pieniadze światowej finansjery. Stwierdzić trzeba, że duża część ludzi propagujących komunizm miała pochodzenie żydowskie. Wprowadzenie systemu totalitarnego leżało w interesie finansjery, która widziała w nim oczywisty zysk spowodowany likwidacją konkurencji.

Potrzeba było kilku pokoleń, by z pełnym przekonaniem stwierdzić, że system komunistyczny jest systemem zbrodniczym, lecz mimo to, w dalszym ciągu sa na świecie centra propagacji komunizmu, które operują pozornie wbrew logice i duchowi czasu.

Ludzkie zdolności przystosowawcze są jednak bardzo elastyczne i nawet do komunizmu można się "przyzwyczaić". Daje dowód na to jednostki ludzkie, których dewiza życiowa jest przede wszystkiem "respekt dla władzy".

Dzieki takiej naturalnej reakcji, ludzie stali się dla siebie

Ci wlasnie nauczeni komunizmem "nie podskocza" i zawsze "zadenuncjuja" bez wzgledu na cel, czy skutki swoich akcji. Tak samo opluja wlasna matke, ojca czy ojczyzne, o ile tylko "Wladza" im w tym przykłasnie. To wlasnie produkt zamordyzmu. Rzadzacy potrzebuja takich wiecej ! Komunistyczny (... i hitlerowski) eksperiment dal sporo materialu do przemyslenia, a dobrani naukowcy skwapliwie sporządzali notatki. Obecne rezultaty to juz teraz klasyka psychologii stosowanej. Teraz aplikuje sie rzatelna wiedze, by jak najefektywniej z ludzi robic idiotow ?

Oto rezultaty :

Deprawacje uzyskuje sie poprzez systematyczna, naukowo opracowana propagande oraz wprowadzanie specyficznych "reform" spolecznych, by zwiększc efektywnosc calego "projektu".

Calosc mozna rozwiniac na nastepujace pola dzialania :

- 1) inspirowanie awansu dolow spolecznych (... np.czarnych !)...
- 2) sztuczne zanizanie wrazliwosci na zlo...
- 3) propagacja seksu, zwyrodnien i bezkarnosci...
- 4) celowe wprowadzanie sprzecznosci...
- 5) osmieszczanie lub zanizanie wartosci dobra...
- 6) propagacja snobizmu...
- 7) propagacja sily oraz dominujacej roli pieniadza...
- 8) zanizanie wydolnosci intelektualnej...

Po takim "treningu" przecietny "kursant" uwaza ze:

Czlowiek od zwierzecia sie nie rozni.
Wszyscy sa rowni, "rasizm" to przestepstwo,
Tradycja to przezytek,
Skromny i dobry to slaby,
Biedny i glodny to zly,
Wierny, szczery i uczciwy to glupi.
Madrosc to spryt,
Spryt to posiadanie,
Etyka to placic za zakupy,
Posiadanie to sila,
Bogaty to dobry,
Religia to zabobon,
Tylko sila wymaga respektu. Itd itd.

I czasami zadaje pytanie:

"Co sie powinno rozumieć pod slowem deprawacja ??!!"

Podobny trening przechodzili wszyscy w PRL. Nie wszyscy ulegli. Wielu zachowalo swa polskosc, godnosc, altruizm i inne cechy, tak wartosciowe, jak prosty szacunek dla siebie i innych.

Ci tez zachowuja dalej respekt dla narodowych tradycji i kieruja sie honorem.

1. JAKOSIEKO Z - BILETY, SKLEADY WITMIEC
2. LIST PO AMBASADY - ZAPROSZONE
- KANCELNE
- VOTY.

Wielu niestety upadlo, utracilo wiare, ... i za cene watpliwego awansu, przyswoilo sobie te wszystkie propagandowe bzdury.

Ci wlasnie starali sie dolaczac do tych wymienionych w grupie 1-szej, by poznajec, juz jako "wybranczy", w ramach "nagrody" (tzw. Polserwisu), przekraczac granice PRL i odwiedzacz ten "zgnily Zachod".

Z regoly byli to "sami swoi", partyjniacy lub inni, bowiem zwykli ludzie nie mieli szans wizytowac zagranicy.

A jezeli juz, to zona, syn lub matka musieli zostac, bo PRL musial miec zakladnikow na miejscu.

Widziano kiedys przypadkowo takich "wybrancow" w austriackiej kawiarence w Traisckirchen, wlasnie tam, gdzie byl oboz dla uciekinierow ze Wschodu. (rok 1974...)

Gdy uslyszano wzajemne polskie slowa i doszlo do swiadomosci "wybrancow", ze ich rozmowcy "wybrancami" nie sa, ci wstali, opuscili kawiarenke i w panice odjechali.

Udowodnili jasno w ten sposob, jaka przepasc istnieje miedzy tymi, którzy wybrali prawdziwa wolnosc i opuscili PRL (legalnie lub nie-legalnie !), a tymi, którzy ta wolnosc otrzymali tylko w ramach "nagrody" (...za lojalnosc... !!).

Przykre to, bo przeciez jedni i drozdy rozmawiali tym samym polskim jezykiem.

Nie wolno tutaj zapominac o masie Polskiego Narodu, ktoru w granicach PRL, nie majac mozliwosci ani woli opuszczenia kraju, musiala znosic na co dzien "wladze ludowa" i wyszukane kaprysy naszych "wybrancow".

Pomimo obecnych zmian i upadku tzw. zelaznej kurtyny, "wybranczy" wcale nie zaprzestali byc "wybrancami". "Wyksztalciuchy" rowniez nie zaprzestali byc "wyksztalciuchami". Lecz mniejsza o terminologie lub nazwe tych ludzi, choc chyba najlepsze imie dla nich to **DEPRAWANCY**. Wybieram to imie, bo jest tylko jedna cecha tych ludzi, ktoru oddziela ich od zdrowego spoleczenstwa: **WYPACZONY CHARAKTER !**

A oto ich cechy charakterystyczne,
po ktorych mozna ich poznac:

- 1) wstydza sie polskosci lub polskiego patriotyzmu,
- 2) z regoly sa ateistami (lub udaja katolikow!),
- 3) separuja sie od polskiego narodu, a preferuja grupe 1-sza,
- 4) uwazaja sie za cos lepszego, holduja obcym autorytetom,
- 5) kieruja sie zawsze pieniedzmi, korzyscia, a nie dobrem ogolu,
- 6) sa konformistyczni, falszywi i bez honoru,
- 7) sa cyniczni, a ich zasady etyczne wydaja sie byc sztuczne,

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This list was first compiled with assumption that it might not be complete and that some names might have been omitted. Also the spelling of names and christian names was not guaranteed.

After many hours of work, inquiries and research, I have tried to draught once more this list after correcting, to the best of my knowledge and memory, first the initials of some of the christian names, second some of the qualifications and last and not least I added six more names that had been left out.

Futhermore, I have tried to point out on the list, the belgian personnel who trained exclusively with the South African Air Force and the belgian personnel who trained in South Africa with the Royal Air Force thus under the Empire Training Scheme.

It is to be recorded that from the first contingent (C1) to the eighth contingent (C8) included, the belgian personnel had been trained strictly on the same bases as the South African Air Force personnel. That is to say a belgian pupil pilot when qualified, received the SAAF pilot's wings and the same applied to all other categories.

The belgian personnel from contingent (C9) to the last contingent (C12) including some belgian personnel from earlier contingents who for different reasons had changed category received Royal Air Force qualifications.

Indeed one will remember that in November 1943 it was decided that the belgian personnel already qualified or/and still present in South Africa were to make the choice of either joining the Royal Air Force or to return to the Belgian Congo, while the new contingents would operate under the new statute. To that effect F/LT ADAMS and P/O S.W.WARDELL DHQ/RAF at Robert's Heights (Pretoria) were detailed and placed in charge of the recruitment and then the following document was presented to everyone to sign :

"I hereby declare that I wish to be attested in the Royal Air Force. I fully understand that after having so attested I shall if qualified be posted to the United Kingdom or if under training continue my training in South Africa and then be posted to the United Kingdom to serve in the RAF/VR if possible in the Belgian UK Squadrons.

I hereby undertake then to serve in the Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve for the duration of the emergency and for six months thereafter unless legally discharged".

Here follows an explanation of the different terms used in establishing the list :

- Returned to the Congo is to indicate the belgian personnel who either joined the Aviation Militaire Force Publique in the Belgian Congo or the ones given other assignments.
- Middle East, UK are self explanatory.
- C1 to C12 are the contingents that one would belong to. The first contingent departed from Elisabethville in the Belgian Congo on the 28th of July 1941 followed by the other contingents at the rate of one a month.
- The dates shown in brackets records the belgians "Killed in action or Died on Service".
- The sign ♀ ✝ indicates the belgian personnel known to be killed in a flying accident (non military).
- The sign ♀ indicates the belgian personnel known to be deceased since the present list was established.

STANISLAW CZUBA

BORN ON 11.12.1919 IN CENTRAL POLAND. ALTHOUGH NOW IT IS NOT THE CENTRE OF POLAND DUE TO YALTA AGREEMENT.

BROUGHT UP AND EDUCATED IN WARSAW.

IN MAY 1939 WAS CALLED UP AND JOINED UNIT ATTACHED TO CHIEF OF STAFF OF POLISH ARMED FORCES IN WARSAW.

IN FIRST DAYS OF SEPTEMBER 1939 STANISLAW CZUBA TOOK PART IN EXCHANGE OPERATION OF GERMAN DIPLOMATIC PERSONNEL IN POLAND TO LITHUANIA AND POLISH DIPLOMATIC PERSONNEL IN GERMANY TO HOLLAND. ON 18TH SEPTEMBER STANISLAW CZUBA CROSSED THE RUMANIA BORDER JUST IN TIME BEFORE RUSSIAN FORCES ENTERED THE AREA.

IN RUMANIA STANISLAW CZUBA TOOK PART IN ORGANISING ESCAPES FROM INTERNMENT CAMPS OF POLISH AIR FORCE PERSONNEL, WHO BY PREARRANGED ROUTES WERE TAKEN TO FRANCE AND UK. FROM THE END OF OCTOBER GERMAN AGENTS TRIED TO UPSET THIS OPERATION AT ALL OF ITS STAGES.

AT THE END OF DECEMBER 1939, STANISLAW CZUBA ARRIVED IN FRANCE WHERE HE JOINED POLISH MILITARY TRAINING CENTRE IN CUETQUIDAN, AND WENT THROUGH NUMBER OF POLISH AND FRENCH COURSES

IN BEGINNING OF JUNE HIS UNIT WAS POSTED TO DEFEND LARGE MUNITION DEPOT. THEY WERE OVERRUN BY GERMANS BUT STANISLAW CZUBA MANAGED TO REACH ST. MALO AND FOUND BOAT WHICH TOOK HIM TO SCOTLAND.

ON 28TH AUGUST 1940 HE JOINED POLISH NAVY AND ON COMPLETING BASIC AND SPECIAL POLISH AND BRITISH COURSES WAS POSTED ON POLISH SUBMARINE ORP WILK.

FROM THE SUBMARINE BASE IN DUNDEE, ORP WILK OPERATED ALONG THE NORWEIGEN COAST. AFTER FEW PATROLS, HAD UNDERWATER COLLISION WITH GERMAN U BOAT. ORP WILK WAS NOT BADLY DAMAGED, BUT AFTER FEW MORE PATROLS, WAS WITHDRAWN FROM ACTIVE SERVICE.

AFTER THE WAR, IT WAS CONFIRMED THAT GERMAN U BOAT WAS SUNK AT THE TIME AND POSITION OF COLLISION.

ON THE 5TH MARCH 1941, STANISLAW CZUBA WAS POSTED TO POLISH SUBMARINE ORP SOKOL, WHICH OPERATED FROM MALTA-VALETTA DURING MOST DIFFICULT PERIOD AT THAT TIME, SHORTAGE OF FOOD, AND HEAVY AIR BOMBARDMENT EVERY 2 HOURS.

ORP SOKOL HAD VERY SUCCESSFUL PATROLS, AND SUNK MANY ITALIAN AND GERMAN SHIPS, BUT LUCKILY MISSED MANY DEPTH CHARGES, AND ON ONE OCCASION, GETTING OUT OF NET AND MANY MORE DEPTH CHARGES AGAIN.

UNFORTUNATELY, DURING ONE OF THE PATROLS, WAS CAUGHT BY VERY BAD STORM. LOST ONE PROPELLER AND DAMAGED MAIN SHAFT AND DEVELOPED

LEAK WHICH REACHED BATTERY COMPARTMENT, AND THERE WAS EMISSION OF CHLORINE GAS. FORTUNATELY, MANAGED TO REACH GIBRALTAR WHERE PROVISIONAL REPAIR TOOK LONG TIME

FROM ORP SOKOL, STANISLAW CZUBA WAS POSTED TO ORP DZIK ANOTHER SUBMARINE BEING BUILT IN BURROW IN FURNESS. AFTER TESTS AND FEW PATROLS, WENT BACK TO MEDITERRANIAN AND FINNALLY MALTA ON 5.5.1943. ORP DZIK WAS A HAPPY AND LUCKY SHIP. WITHIN FEW MONTHS OUR JOLLY ROGER -PIRATEFLAG WAS SHOWING 18 SHIPS SUNK'

ITALY SURRENDERED ON 15.9.43.

BEGINNING OF MAY 1944, STANISLAW CZUBA BOARDED ORP DRAGON POLISH CRUISER. ON 6TH JUNE 1944 DRAGON WAS SECOND IN LINE ENTERING NORMANDY WATERS AND OUR SECTION SWARD. INVASION OF EUROPE BEGAN. IT WAS HELL FOR A NUMBER OF HOURS, AND THE GUNS OF ORP DRAGON WERE DOING GOOD JOB. FEW DAYS LATER THEY HAD DIRECT HIT ON GERMAN TANK.

ON THE 8TH JULY , ORP DRAGON WAS HIT BY TORPEDO FROM GERMAN MIDGET SUBMARINE - NEGRY., WITH LOSS OF 39 MEN AND THE CRUISER.

ON THE 24TH MARCH 1947, STANISLAW CZUBA WAS A CIVILIAN IN LONDON. AFTER FEW JOBS WITH SMALL COMPANIES, MANAGED TO GET A GOOD POSITION WITH LARGE BRITISH CORPORATE ORGANISATION, IN WHICH HE ROSE TO HIGH MANAGERIAL POSITION.

AS A MEMBER OF BASILDON AND BRENTWOOD INDUSTRIAL COUNCIL 1958-1962 , HE ATTENDED MEETINGS AND DINNERS IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS, AND ON ONE OCCASION MADE A SPEECH .

IN 1969 ARRIVED IN SOUTH AFRICA TO JOIN A BRITISH COMPANY AS EXECUTIVE. DECIDED TO STAY PERMANENTLY IN SOUTH AFRICA AND STARTED HIS OWN COMPANY IN 1973. HE RETIRED A FEW TIMES BUT THE COMPANY STILL EXISTS.

HE JOINED A NUMBER OF POLISH ORGANISATIONS AND SERVED IN THEM IN VARIOUS POSITIONS.

AS THERE WAS ONLY ONE OTHER NAVAL PERSON IN JOHANNESBURG, HE JOINED THE POLISH AIR FORCE ASSOCIATION, AND IN 1993 BECAME CHAIRMAN POLISH AIR FORCE ASSOCIATION IN SOUTH AFRICA.

Service

SINCE 1972 STANISLAW CZUBA NEVER MISSED COMMEMORATION OF BATTLE OF BRITAIN, AND IN THE WORDS OF MR. CHURCHILL:-
"NEVER WAS SO MUCH OWEDED TO SO FEW;"
AND WISH TO ADD THAT: THE FEW MORE POLISH PILOTS FREED IN RUMANIA HELPED TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE BATTLE OF BRITAIN VICTORY.
